

1. Background

○ The Tokyo Metropolitan Government (TMG) and the Tokyo Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Tokyo 2020) must set up live sites within Tokyo and the areas devastated by earthquakes in the Tohoku and Kumamoto regions to allow visitors and spectators from around the world to enjoy viewing live broadcasts of the competition events and share in the emotions and excitement of the Games.

○ After eight proposed sites were announced last April, the TMG and Tokyo 2020 looked into each site's feasibility while conducting field surveys and consulting with relevant parties.

○ Studies for safe and sound operations were conducted to ensure that security measures matching the respective features of each site are in place and to reduce the number of large-scale Live Sites.

2. Sites

○ All eight of the proposed sites in Tokyo will be used to widely welcome the large number of visitors and spectators from around the world.

○ Content and operations will be decided according to each site's specific circumstances.

○ The sites for Tokyo Public Viewings in the Tama area have been decided as below to raise Tokyo-wide enthusiasm for the Games.

○ The TMG and Tokyo 2020 will steadily proceed with preparations based on the Basic Plan for Tokyo 2020 Live Sites and Public Viewings.

① Tokyo 2020 Live Sites (Jointly hosted by TMG and Tokyo 2020)

○ Sites in the Tokyo 23-ward area and the Tama area will be used as large-scale Live Sites to widely accommodate, not only Tokyo residents, but spectators and other visitors from within and outside of Japan. Along with live broadcasts of the competition events on large screens, excitement for the Games will be raised by conveying the appeal of Tokyo and Japan and through Games marketing partner exhibits and others.

② Tokyo 2020 Live Sites around terminal stations (Jointly hosted by TMG and Tokyo 2020)

○ Sites will be set up around terminal stations that are convenient and easily accessible from within and out of Tokyo, welcoming visitors and spectators from around the world. By cooperating with Games marketing partners and utilizing existing facilities, it is planned to effectively raise enthusiasm for the Games.

③ Tokyo Public Viewings

○ Taking the opportunity presented by the Games, it is important that various stakeholders endeavor to convey the appeal of Tokyo and Japan including the diversity of culture and food, and promote tourism and more to together raise excitement for the Games.

○ The TMG will prepare site locations in the Tokyo 23-ward area and the Tama area, and along with live broadcasts of the competition events, will cooperate with booths, events, and other activities of various organizations and local communities.

④ Areas for Tokyo 2020-centered activities

○ Tokyo Waterfront (Aomi, Ariake, etc.) is a special place where many competition venues, such as urban sports are found. Enthusiasm for the Games will be raised here as a symbolic area for the Games.

○ Centering on Tokyo 2020, while receiving the cooperation of the TMG, Games marketing partners and local communities, and while taking into consideration the Games operations, further studies will be conducted on how to make these special areas where visitors can experience the excitement of the Games.

3. Period and Time

(1) Period

- Tokyo 2020 Live Sites Tokyo 23-ward area and Tama area site locations: Basically the total 30 days of the Games
- Other sites: Details to be studied

(2) Time

Studies to be conducted by site, centering on the time when most sports events are being held (from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.)

4. Visitor Estimates

○ Based on each site's usable area, content, location and other characteristics, it is estimated that there will be over 95,000 visitors a day to sites within Tokyo and a total of 2.85 million visitors during the Games.

○ Visitor estimates for sites in the Tohoku and Kumamoto regions will be prepared during site studies.

5. Notes

○ The organisers will provide their own security and fully cooperate with local police and other relevant agencies.

○ Will implement both tangible and intangible heat prevention measures such as installing sun-blocking tents and mist sprays.

○ Along with setting up accessible routes and areas within the sites, Wi-Fi networks will be installed.

○ Will study making the Live Sites and other venues smoke-free.

○ Will study using non-plastic dishware and implementing recycling to be environmentally friendly.

○ The TMG will provide support to municipalities holding Community Live Sites and other activities in the form of subsidies as well as appropriate provision of information and implementation of various consultations.
